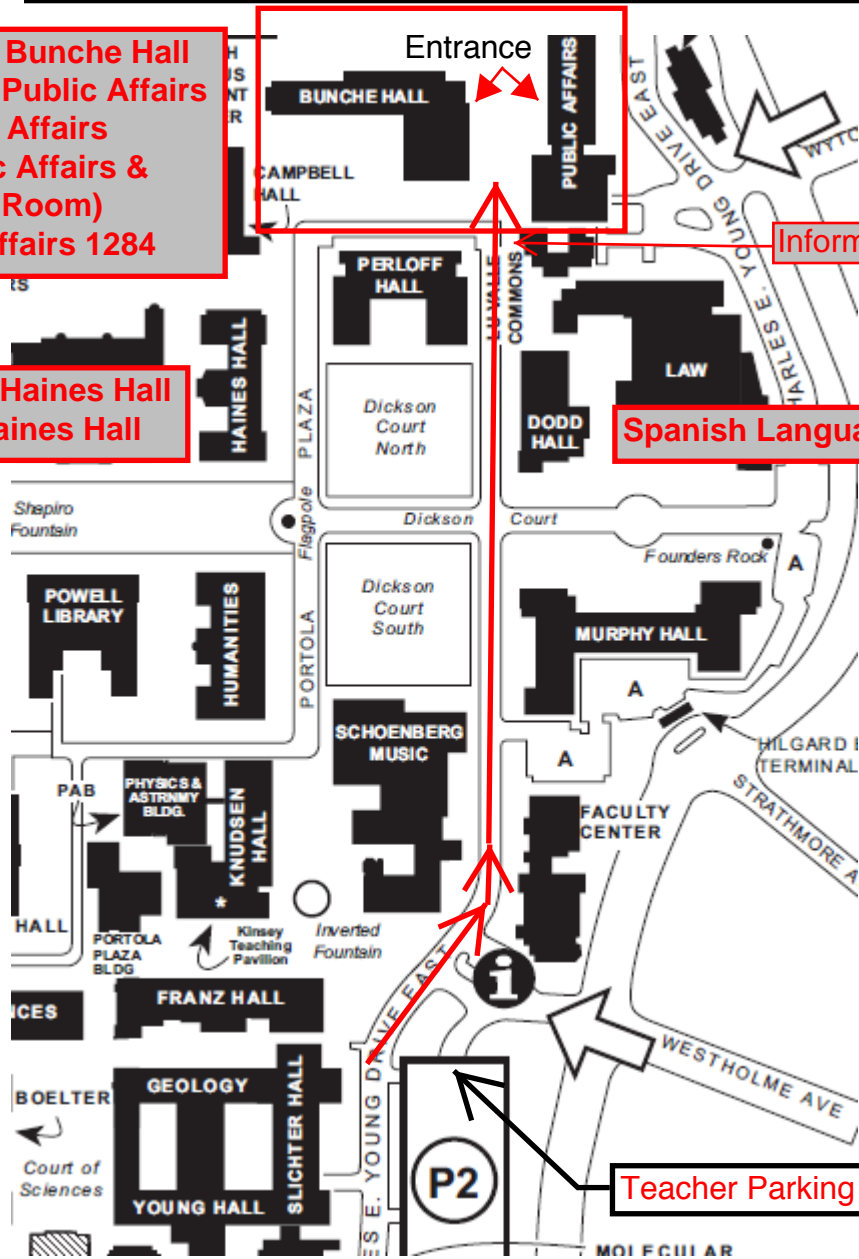
# AP READINESS MAP
